(2) Mighty God

Isaiah 9:6...

Leviticus 15:19-26

*"19 'When a woman has her regular flow of blood, the impurity of her monthly period will last seven days, and anyone who touches her will be **unclean** till evening. 20 'Anything she lies on during her period will be **unclean**, and anything she sits on will be **unclean**. 21 Anyone who touches her bed will be **unclean**; they must wash their clothes and bathe with water, and they will be **unclean** till evening. 22 Anyone who touches anything she sits on will be **unclean**; they must wash their clothes and bathe with water, and they will be **unclean** till evening. 23 Whether it is the bed or anything she was sitting on, when anyone touches it, they will be **unclean** till evening. 24 'If a man has sexual relations with her and her monthly flow touches him, he will be **unclean** for seven days; any bed he lies on will be **unclean**. 25 'When a woman has a discharge of blood for many days at a time other than her monthly period or has a discharge that continues beyond her period, she will be **unclean** as long as she has the discharge, just as in the days of her period. 26 Any bed she lies on while her discharge continues will be **unclean**, as is her bed during her monthly period, and anything she sits on will be **unclean**, as during her period. 27 Anyone who touches them will be **unclean**; they must wash their clothes and bathe with water, and they will be **unclean** till evening."*

Malachi 4:2

"But for you who fear my name, the Sun of Righteousness will rise with healing in his wings. And you will go free, leaping with joy like calves let out to pasture."

Mark 5:21

"When Jesus had again crossed over by boat to the other side of the lake, a large crowd gathered around him while he was by the lake."

Vs. 22-24

"22 Then one of the synagogue leaders, named Jairus, came, and when he saw Jesus, he fell at his feet. 23 He pleaded earnestly with him, 'My little daughter is dying. Please come and put your hands on her so that she will be healed and live.' 24 So Jesus

went with him. A large crowd followed and pressed around him.”

“And a woman was there who had been subject to bleeding for twelve years.”

Vs.26

“She had suffered a great deal under the care of many doctors and had spent all she had, yet instead of getting better she grew worse.”

Vs.27

“When she heard about Jesus...”

27 When she heard about Jesus, she came up behind him she came up behind him in the crowd and touched his cloak, 28 because she thought, “If I just touch his clothes I will be healed.”

Vs.29

“Immediately her bleeding stopped and she felt in her body that she was freed from her suffering.”

Vs.30

“At once Jesus realized that power had gone out from him. He turned around in the crowd and asked, “Who touched my clothes?”

Vs.31

“You see the people crowding against you,” his disciples answered, “and yet you can ask, ‘Who touched me?’ ”

Vs.32-33

“32 But Jesus kept looking around to see who had done it. 33 Then the woman, knowing what had happened to her, came and fell at his feet and, trembling with fear, told him the whole truth.”

Isaiah 64:6

“We have ALL become like one who is unclean, and all our righteous deeds are like a polluted garment (menstrual rag). We all fade like a leaf, and our iniquities, like the wind, take us away.”
