"He had seven sons and three daughters"

Vs.3

"and he owned seven thousand sheep..."

"three thousand camels..."

"five hundred yoke of oxen and five hundred donkeys..."

"and had a large number of servants. He was the greatest man among all the people of the East."

JOB 42:12

"The Lord blessed the latter part of Job's life more than the former part..."

"He had fourteen thousand sheep..."

"six thousand camels..."

"a thousand yoke of oxen and a thousand donkeys..."

"and, he also had 7 sons and 3 daughters."

Job 1:4-5

"His sons used to hold feasts in their homes on their birthdays, and they would invite their three sisters to eat and drink with them. When a period of feasting had run its course, Job would make arrangements for them to be purified."

"Early in the morning he would sacrifice a burnt offering for each of them, thinking, "Perhaps my children have sinned and cursed God in their hearts." This was Job's regular custom."
